





CAAS Apartments can host 14 participants



DUBROVNIK – HOW TO ARRIVE?

By plane: The easiest and most comfortable way to get to Dubrovnik is by plane. Dubrovnik Airport is about 20 km (12 miles) from Dubrovnik. This is an international airport connected to many European cities, especially during the summer.

The regular Dubrovnik Airport Shuttle Bus service is provided by Atlas Agency.

The journey takes approximately 30 min.

On the way from the Airport the bus shuttle stops at <u>Pile Gate</u> next to the Old Town and CAAS.



DUBROVNIK – HOW TO ARRIVE?

By bus: Dubrovnik is connected by bus with most Croatian cities and some international destinations.

Estimated trip duration to Dubrovnik from: Zagreb – 10 hours Split – 4 hours

Rijeka – 12 hours

By car: Public Garage in the vicinity of CAAS

By ship: Connecting Croatian and Italian ports

Local public transportation: City buses connect directly all hotels with CAAS and Old Town.
